12 The original fee for the addition and equipping of the cardio room and the weight room expansion was assessed in 2002 and approved with a $5 \%$ escalator for ten years. The state intercap loan will be paid off in FY2009. Next fiscal year will mark the seventh year of the plan. This fee is used to fund daily operations, for maintenance and replacement of equipment, and for related deferred maintenance needs.
13 The increase will assist Tech in covering insurance and increased travel costs. The increase is relatively insignificant in financing related athletic expenditures.
