Dear Members of the Board:

As you know, construction is underway on the new Native American Center on the campus of The University of Montana - Missoula. Located on the southwest corner of the oval, the Native American Center will be the first academic center of its kind in the nation and will provide a place for all those interested to explore and celebrate Indian history, culture, heritage and perspectives. The planning and building of the Native American Center has been a long and arduous task and could not have been possible with the strong support of our lead donor, Terry Payne.

Terry Payne and his wife, Patt, are highly committed to the Native American Center. Terry's history with UM is long and successful. He received a bachelor's degree in business administration from UM in1963. He is the founder and principal of Terry Payne and Co., Inc., an independent insurance agency established in Missoula in 1972. In a nut-shell, Terry is a successful businessman who finds it in his heart to support many area organizations. It is therefore our wish, with your approval, to name the new Native American Center on the campus of UM the *Payne Family Native American Center* in honor of Terry's contributions.
