## Specify Request:

The Mathematics Department proposes to consolidate all of its program offerings into a single B.S. Major in Mathematics with Options in Mathematical Biology; Mathematical Ecology; and Mathematical Geology. This would replace the current B.A. Option in Mathematics with its Related Areas (Sub-Options) in Mathematical Biology; Mathematical Ecology; Mathematical Geology; and Mathematical Physics. The Core of the proposed major could also be coupled with a Secondary Education Major for a double Major that would prepare mathematics teachers. This double major would replace the Mathematics Option ("Major") under the current B.S. Secondary Education Major. None of these changes would require additional coursework or faculty.
