## Statutory authority:

Chapter 658, Montana Session Laws 1987, House Bill 39

Section 21. Tuition rates.

(1) Tuition may be charged to any resident or nonresident of the state of Montana by the director of any vocational-technical center at rates to be determined by the board of regents and the provisions of subsection (3). The board of regents shall prescribe permissible uses for any tuition authorized.

(2) For the purposes of this section the eligibility of a student for resident statusshall be determined in the same manner as that prescribed for use by the-Montana university system, except that those provisions referring to 'high schoolgraduates" or "graduation from high school" shall be considered to refer to aperson who has attended school or who was in attendance at a school.

(3) If an additional levy for a center is approved under section 27, the board of regents may charge an additional tuition amount not to exceed \$40 a quarter to a student at the center who is a resident of Montana but who is not a property taxpayer of the county or an owner of a vehicle registered within the county where the center is located.
