

# STUDENT RECREATION FACILITIES PROJECT

## MSU-BOZEMAN STUDENT BODY VOTE, APRIL 2017

- Record Voter Turnout: 22%
- Nearly a 2-1 Vote in Favor: 62.5% Yes

## ADDITIONAL FUNDING BENEFITS FOR MSU RSO'S & CLUB TEAMS

- 60% of students (255 clubs and orgs) would benefit from the increased funding
- \$50+k in additional funding for student organizations
- \$25k in additional funding for Club Sports
- RSO'S ran out of rolling funding the first week of spring semester this year



## TURF FIELD BENEFITS FOR MSU STUDENTS

- Use of turf in most weather conditions
  - Turf would be plowed in winter for Club Sport Practice and special events
  - Typical Spring weather cancels most Intramural games and club outdoor practices
- The new Rugby sized field would allow multiple clubs or IM practices/games at the same time
- The MSU marching band, Fraternities/Sororities and other MSU groups would also use the field

## BY THE NUMBERS:

- 25- Number of Club Sport Teams at MSU totaling 550 students
- 66%- Percentage of days in Spring 2017 that Clubs and IM's were unable to use the natural grass fields due to weather
- \$350k- Amount Club Sport teams have requested in funding for 2017-18 (only \$50k funded)
