<u>Request for Authorization to Construct Five Academic Buildings to Serve the Mark & Robyn Jones</u> <u>College of Nursing; Montana State University</u>

THAT

Consistent with MCA 18-2-102 and BOR Policy 1003.7, the Board of Regents authorizes Montana State University to expend up to \$92,000,000 for the construction of up to five (5) academic buildings to serve the Mark & Robyn Jones College of Nursing in Billings, Bozeman, Great Falls, Kalispell, and Missoula.

EXPLANATION

- 1. MSU received \$92,000,000 of legislative authority only for the construction of academic buildings to serve the Mark & Robyn Jones College of Nursing in House Bill 5 of the 68th Legislative Session.
- 2. The project will leverage the \$101 million investment Mark & Robyn Jones provided to transform healthcare delivery in Montana for the benefit of current and future generations.
- 3. The project will construct five academic buildings across the state of Montana to train the best nurses of tomorrow across communities facing the realities of nursing shortages.
- 4. MSU, the State of Montana, and hired design professionals have completed initial planning, programming, and schematic design as authorized under BOR Item 196-2009-R0921.
- 5. Project plant funds from donor accounts will pay for the work on this project.
