Request for Authorization to Increase Spending Authority to Replace the Rimrock Hall Elevator; Montana State University Billings

THAT

Consistent with the authority of the Montana Board of Regents to manage and control the Montana University System, BOR Policy 1003.7, and 20-25-302 (1)(b), the Board of Regents authorizes Montana State University Billings (MSUB) to increase general spending authority by \$753,675 for the replacement of the Rimrock Hall passenger elevator.

EXPLANATION

- 1. ITEM 183-2701-R0519 was approved in May 2019, authorizing the expenditure of up to \$450,000 to design and replace two passenger elevators in Rimrock Hall.
- 2. Additional authority of \$753,675 is requested due to market cost escalation and associated cost-estimating exercises.
- 3. Rimrock Hall is a student residence building constructed in 1962. The current elevator is beyond its life expectancy and costs have risen since the original approval in 2019.
- 4. Replacing the elevator is essential in providing accessibility to the upper floors of Rimrock Hall to the students, custodial and maintenance staff, and others visiting the residence hall.
- 5. MSUB has begun engineering work with the authority received in 2019.
- 6. Funding for this purchase will come from non-state funds, specifically auxiliary revenues from revenue-producing facilities in excess of bond payment obligations.
- 7. No additional O&M will be requested for this project.
