Transfer: For students entering this program that have completed a nursing program, transfer of those nursing credits will be considered as a block. If the student has not completed a nursing program, transfer of nursing courses will be considered individually. Transfer of general education course work will be considered according to each individual course.

The Associate of Science degree in Nursing leading to eligibility to sit for the National Council of Licensing Examination-RN (NCLEX-RN) allows the student an exit point after three semesters of study. After three semesters of successful instruction, the student is eligible to sit for the NCLEX-PN. Successfully completing this examination awards the student his/her license in practical nursing, which is required for entry into the Associate of Science in Nursing program. LPN licensure in the state of Montana validates prior learning and educational competence.
