Building Maintenance Fee	127-101-R0505	Per credit hour fee to provide for repair, maintenance and renovation costs for all facilities. (Split \$2.25 to Building Maintenance and \$1.00 to Building Access.) (Capped at 12 credit hours.)
Computer Fee	127-101-R0505	Per credit hour fee used primarily to replace classroom computers. (Capped at 12 credit hours.)
Technology Fee	127-101-R0505	Per credit hour fee used primarily to replace software and network systems. (Capped at 12 credit hours.)
Equipment Fee	127-101-R0505	Per credit hour fee used primarily to update equipment for technical and trades programs. (Capped at 12 credit hours.)
Academic Facility Fee	127-101-R0505	Per credit hour fee pledged for bond debt repayment. (Capped at 12 credit hours.)
Student Government Fee	127-101-R0505	Flat fee charge to all enrolling students each semester.
Student Union Fee	127-101-R0505	Per credit hour fee pledge for bond debt repayment. (Capped at 18 credit hours.)
Utility Surcharge Fee	127-101-R0505	Per credit hour fee to offset increasing utility costs. (Capped at 12 credit hours.)
