As soon as an application is received, everyone involved in the IE3 program begins an intensive process of reviewing and evaluating the applications (e.g. interviews, gathering all application materials from student, and forwarding materials to Regional Directors). Other costs associated with operating the program include marketing, advising students, facilitating the financial aid and registration issues on behalf of the student, workshops and orientations, and recording of internship credits. Fees are set at a lower amount than other IE3 partner institutions to ensure the program is affordable for UM students.
