Registration	127-101-R0505	Registration Fee is a flat fee charged to each student to cover the administrative costs of registration.
Building Fee	127-101-R0505	Building Fee is a per credit hour charge used to repay debt and to pay for operation and maintenance of buildings.
SFEP Fee	127-101-R0505	SFEP Fee includes funds pledged for debt service on the Student Facilities Enhancement Project, as well as Operations & Maintenance fee for the Health & PE Complex.
Computer Fee	127-101-R0505	Computer Fee is a per credit hour fee used to provide and enhance student computer labs and access.
SU Fee	127-101-R0505	The Student Union Fee provides for the operation and maintenance of the Health Service and the Strand Union.
Equipment Fee	127-101-R0505	Equipment Fee is a per credit hour fee used to provide and enhance classroom and student lab equipment.
Information Technology Fee	127-101-R0505	Information Technology Fee is a flat fee for all students used to enhance and maintain the university's computer network.
ASMSU Fee	127-101-R0505	ASMSU Fee (formerly Activity Fee) supports the operation of the student government (ASMSU) and its committees, as well as providing access to fitness facilities and other activities. Also included is a Bus Fee that funds ASMSU's contribution to the Streamline Bus System.
Health Fee	127-101-R0505	Health & Dental Fee is assessed to provide health and dental services to students.
