An MSU alumnus and his wife will donate a \$1 million portion of their estate to support the university's Hilleman Scholars Program, which helps Montana high school graduates succeed in college.

In what is the most significant discovery in astronomy since the Nobel Prize-winning detection of gravitational waves, MSU physicists were part of an international team to detect gravitational waves from the collision of two neutron stars and provided further evidence of how how gold and platinum are formed.

MSU Jake Jabs College of Business and Entrepreneurship students participating in the "Entreprentice Challenge," <u>turned \$25 each into more than \$7,000 in just three weeks</u>, and then donated those funds to three different Montana wildfire-related relief causes.

The Plant Growth Center at MSU recently <u>celebrated its 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary</u>. The center has enabled hundreds of research projects that have contributed important knowledge of diseases, weed management, and more to Montana and beyond.

Montana State University was <u>named a Purple Heart University</u> in recognition of the university's ongoing support for veterans and their families.

Researchers from MSU's Education, Electrical and Computer Engineering, and Physics departments received <u>a</u> <u>\$445,000 National Science Foundation grant</u> to develop a curriculum to improve the spatial intelligence of middle schoolers.

A biostatistician with the Center for Biofilm Engineering at MSU and an assistant professor of chemical and biological engineering have <u>collaborated with the EPA</u> to develop the first antimicrobial testing standards specifically for biofilm bacteria.

MSU Extension family economics specialist Marsha Goetting <u>received the 2017 Western Region Excellence in</u> <u>Extension Award from Cooperative Extension</u>, the USDA's National Institute of Food and Agriculture and the Association of Public and Land-grant Universities.

Bob Hietala, dean of Gallatin College MSU, was <u>named the recipient of Prospera Business Network's 2017</u> <u>Economic Leadership Award</u>.

The McNair Scholars Program that works to support underrepresented undergraduate students has <u>received</u> <u>\$1.2 million from the U.S. Department of Education</u> to continue the program for another five years.

Nearly 1,200 students received their degrees and Dan Wenk, superintendent of Yellowstone National Park, received <u>an honorary doctorate degree in letters</u> at MSU's fall commencement.

The MSU College of Arts and Architecture <u>published</u> *The Artists*, a magazine produced by photography student Kate Chapin for a class.

MSU mechanical and industrial engineering professor Bill Schell has been <u>named a fellow by the American</u> <u>Society for Engineering Management</u>.
