ITEM 183-1008-R0509 Request for Authorization of Social Sciences Datacenter Project – University of Montana-Missoula

THAT

Consistent with Board of Regents Policy 1003.7, the University of Montana-Missoula requests authorization from the Montana the Board of Regents of Higher Education to implement steps necessary to construct a new datacenter on the first floor in Social Sciences and decommission old datacenter in Social Sciences 002.

EXPLANATION

UM is seeking to eliminate our biggest and most inefficient datacenter by relocating the SS002 data center to a more appropriate and efficient space on the first floor in the Social Sciences building. The Social Sciences 002 data center is referred to as the "Core" and is critical to the operation of IT systems (networking, Internet access, e-mail, Banner, etc.) both on the campus and to its remote locations. In addition, this room serves as the "connector" for Miles City Community College, Dawson Community College, UM-Western, Helena College, Montana Tech, and Highlands College. This datacenter uses approximately 8.5 million gallons of water per year, which equates to \$43,755 in wasted utilities expenditures (\$23,268 for water and \$20,487 for sewer annually). This is a critical datacenter that has extreme operational risks. A catastrophic failure in SS002 could result in campus-wide outages for weeks given the space's current condition.

This authority request is for an amount greater than \$150,000, which requires the following additional information:

(a) Project Description:

The work performed under this authority contains the purchase and installation of self-contained data center product and construction in support of that system. The construction will consist of several walls, doors, flooring, extension of fiber optics, electrical circuits and sub-panel, and the placement of HVAC equipment.
