The mission of the Montana Museum of Art and Culture is to actively engage The University of Montana community and a diverse public in the appreciation of arts and culture through collections stewardship, exhibitions, and programs that educate and enrich.

The MMAC, along with the Montana Historical Society and the Museum of the Rockies, is one of three state museums and the only one without a permanent home. Because of its location on the UM campus, it has a national profile and an international audience.

The MMAC's Permanent Collection consists of close to 11,000 artworks and artifacts. Current gallery spaces allow for less than one percent of the collection to be on view at a given moment.

The MMAC's Permanent Collection is comprised of the following:

- Asian art and artifacts
- Rudy Autio Ceramic Collection
- Senator William A. Clark Collection
- Contemporary and Traditional Art by Montana artists
- Contemporary and Traditional Native American work
- Fra Dana Collection of American Impressionism

- Vintage Clothing and Costumes from the 19th & 20th Centuries
- Works by William Merritt Chase, Fra Dana, Ralph DeCamp, John Fery, Alfred Maurer, Edgar Paxson, Frederick Remington, Julius Seyler, Joseph Henry Sharp, and other American and Western artists of reknown.
