

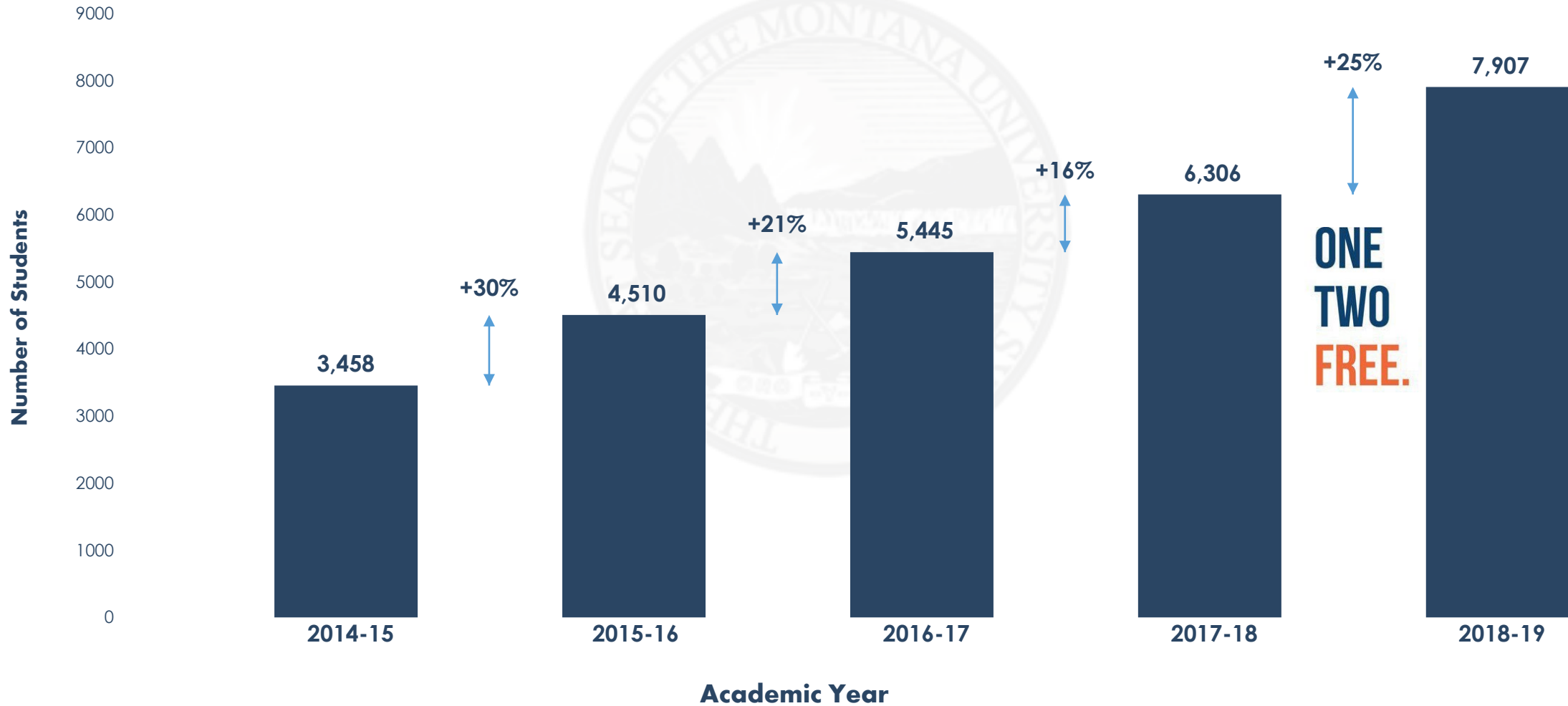

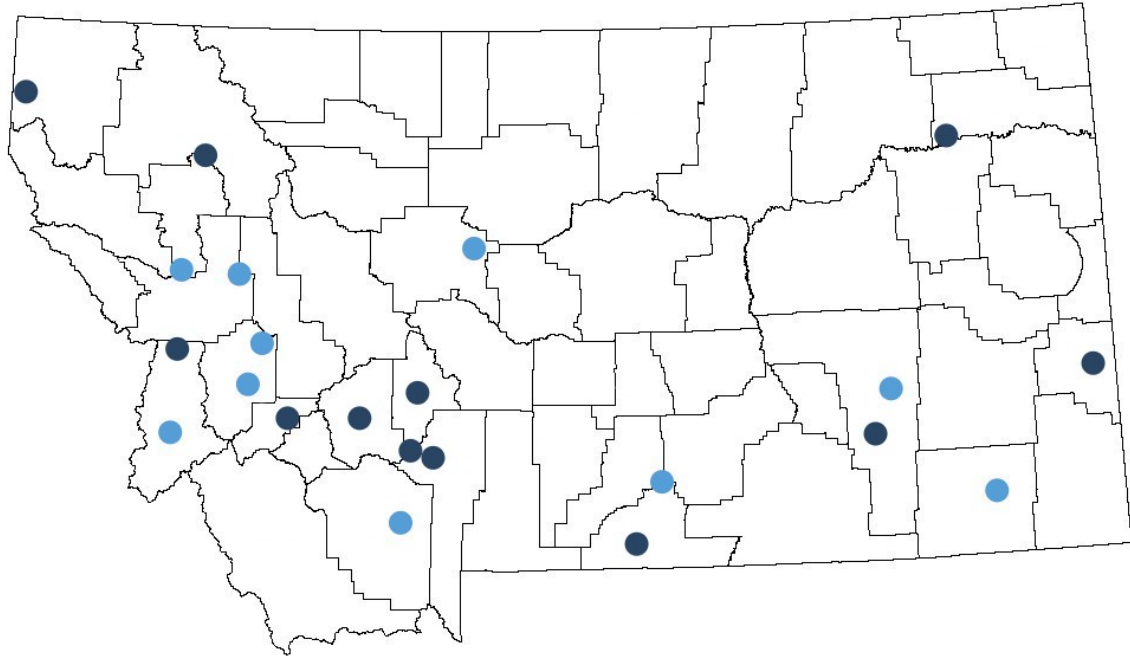
Montana Dual Enrollment Students, 2014-15 to 2018-19

Concurrent Enrollment in Class B & C Public High Schools

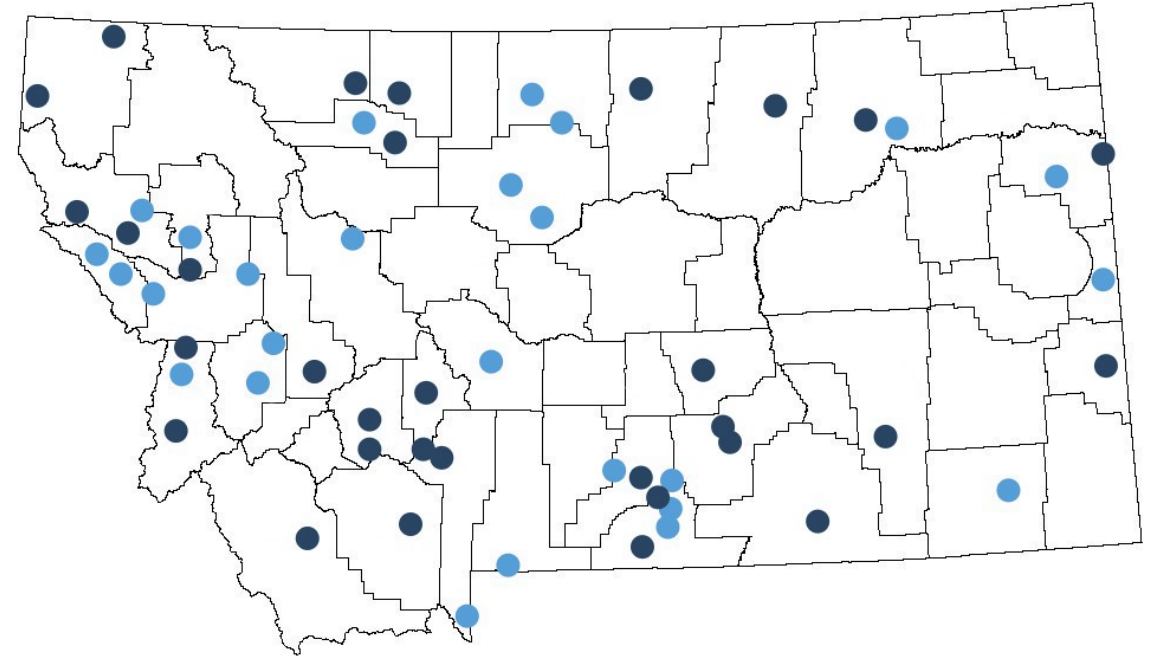

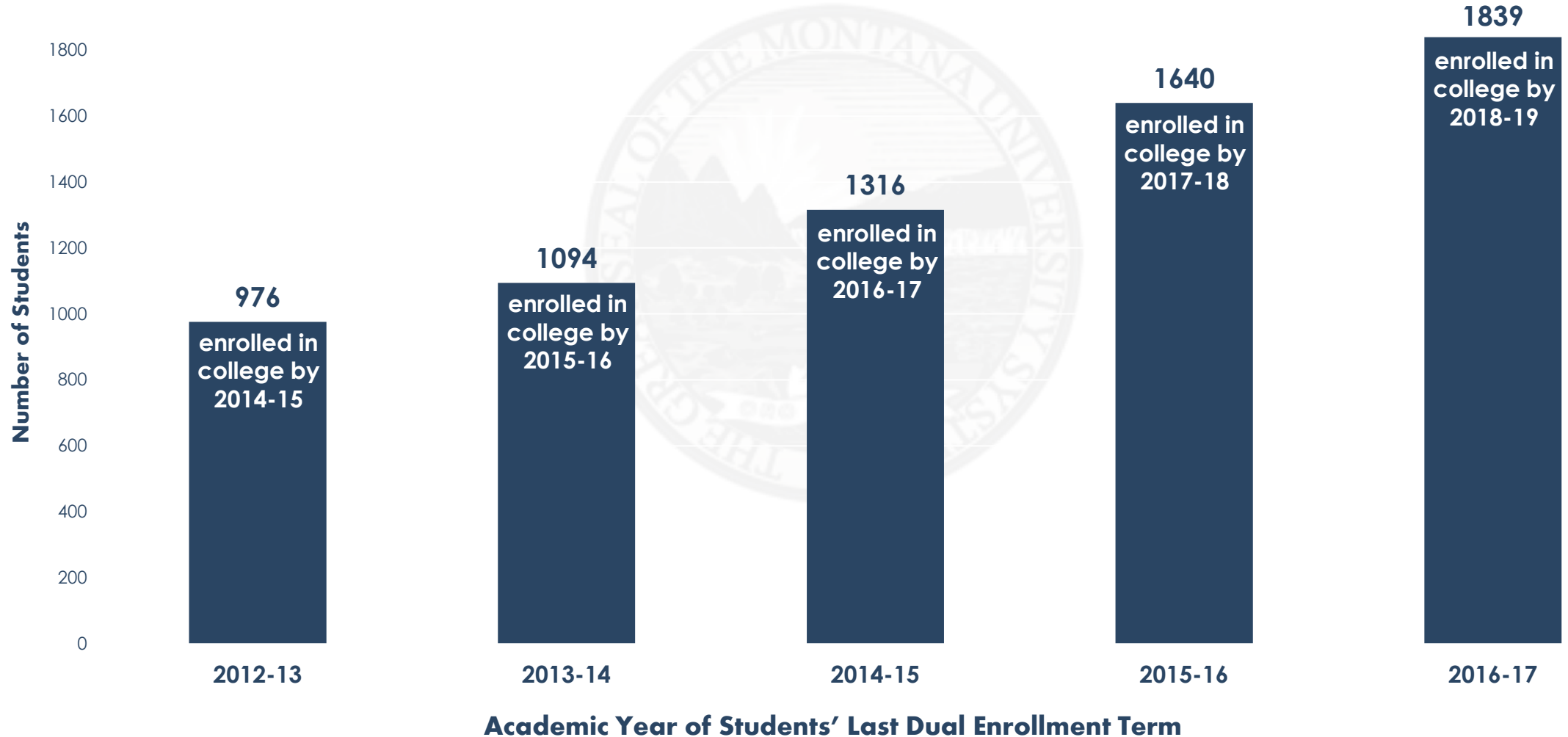

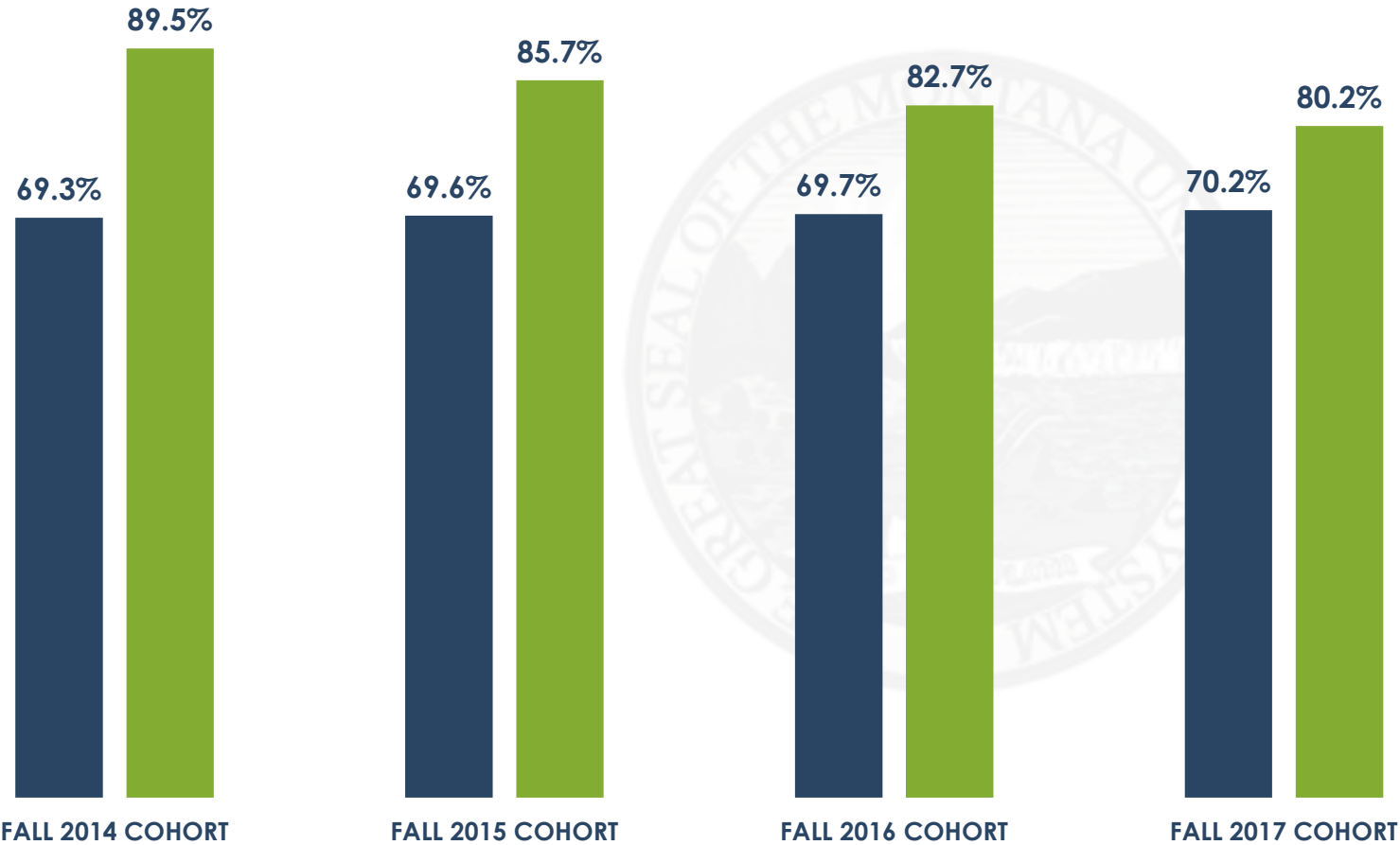
