AIMA College Access and Retention Efforts

- Meetings with MUS campus AISS to assess how they were conducting outreach to American Indian students in a strategic way
- Phone calls/Social Media/Surveys/Texts/Emails were used to reach students and provide support in completing the semester and support towards next Fall



Strategy to consider:

• To better support every American Indian student, ask each campus to build into their AIMA Action Plans an ongoing American Indian student outreach/communication strategy at the campus level that could be employed at any time.



Ongoing Strategies:

- Continue to update and implement campus based AIMA Action Plans.
 - Continue communication through each campus "single point of contact" as well as a "single point of contact" in each department.
 - Continue to require completion of the IEFA for One MUS Course
 - Continue to collect and monitor data as it becomes available.
 - Monitor data on the AIMA Student Success Dashboard.
- Continue to meet with AIMA Council and campus based AISS team members to share resources, discuss campus practices and advise the Commissioner.
