Four MSU students were <u>awarded prestigious Goldwater scholarships</u>, the nation's premier scholarship for undergraduates in the natural sciences, mathematics and engineering, keeping MSU among the top Goldwater universities in the nation. This is the second year in a row that four MSU students were awarded scholarships at once.

Danielle Antelope, a senior from Browning majoring in sustainable food and bioenergy systems, has been named a <u>2020 Newman Civic Fellow</u> for her work to improve the food systems on campus and within the Blackfeet Reservation.

The Caring for Our Own program <u>received a five-year \$2.1 million grant</u> from the Indian Health Service. It will support 10 American Indian nursing students per year with funds for tuition, books and other educational expenses.

MSU researchers were awarded a <u>\$1.17 million National Science Foundation grant</u> to study caddisflies and their effects on stream health.

Joaquin Moterrosa, a Montana State University student double majoring in business and computer science has earned a <u>competitive internship with NASA</u> this summer, where he will be doing computer programming at the Kennedy Space Center.

Andrew Vernooy, professor of architecture, has been elected to the <u>American Institute of Architects' College of</u> <u>Fellows</u> in recognition for exceptional work and contributions to architecture and society.

Organic chemist Sharon Neufeldt is one of 25 educators in the <u>2020 class of Cottrell Scholars</u>, an award honoring academic leadership and innovative research in the physical sciences.

Brian Rossmann, associate professor and associate dean of the MSU Library, was selected for the 2020 <u>UCLA</u> <u>Library Senior Fellows</u> program.

Solar physicist and former astronaut Loren Acton was named to the <u>American Astronomical Society's inaugural</u> group of fellows to recognize his achievement and service.

MSU nursing professor Jennifer Sofie received the American Association of <u>Nurse Practitioners 2020 State</u> <u>Award for Excellence</u>.
