Fall Semester

As we move forward through the coronavirus pandemic, DCC continues to work with the county's health department and is following local, state, and federal guidelines. Enrollment

We are extremely pleased to see significant growth in enrollment this fall. Residence halls are full, and we are in conversations with community partners to meet additional housing demand.

The summer term ended August 17. Resident FTE increased 88% from the 2019 summer term!

<u>Esports</u>

In July, DCC launched an esports team and almost immediately, coaches signed a number of students to play for Dawson. We thank Mid-Rivers Communications for their generous support of this new program. We will host a GameCon event in September, and look forward to competing with other esports teams in the region.

Workforce Development
