MSU's <u>fall commencement</u> recognized approximately 896 undergraduate students, 151 graduate students and 42 Gallatin College students who received their degrees this fall.

MSU is partnering with <u>Idaho National Laboratory</u> on a new <u>\$3.1 million cybersecurity</u> research project funded by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

MSU's College of Agriculture partnered with Blackfeet Community College to receive a grant from the <u>U.S.</u>

<u>Department of Agriculture</u> to facilitate greater opportunities and new programs for Native American students.

An interdisciplinary MSU research team received a \$944,000 National Science Foundation grant to study the efficiency of nitrogen fertilizers and their impact on soil health and water quality, with a focus on central Montana.

Montana State University has received nearly \$300,000 from the <u>U.S. Environmental Protection Agency</u> for a study that aims to help reduce food waste and divert it from landfills.

With two National Science Foundation grants totaling nearly \$1.5 million, Montana State University will <u>invest</u> in two new instruments that are likely to support hundreds of researchers in expanding the boundaries of engineering, chemistry, biology and more.

A \$3 million gift will help launch a new <u>master's in innovation management</u> at MSU that is designed to help recent graduates – particularly those with backgrounds in engineering and STEM – develop professional skills.

Montana State University has been selected to lead a two-year study about the <u>effects of the COVID-19</u> <u>pandemic on nurses</u>, the largest group of U.S. health care workers, focusing on changes in employment, earnings and the supply of nurses.

Bachelor's nursing students from the MSU <u>College of Nursing</u>'s Billings campus supported their local health care community by <u>administering flu vaccinations</u> this fall to hundreds of health care workers and staff at St. Vincent Healthcare in Billings.

The MSU Library will partner with other institutions on a three-year, \$887,154 grant, with the goal of boosting data science capacity through recruiting, training and developing the library workforce.

The Association of Public and Land-grant Universities announced that MSU President Waded Cruzado is the 2021 chair of the board of directors.
