The SUB was remodeled in 1986. The SUB serves as the host location for many public events, and funding is needed to maintain the facility in a manner that meets the expectations of students and quests.

Unfortunately, minimal funding is available through the State of Montana to fund the ongoing and deferred maintenance issues in this facility. The Academic Building Fee is utilized primarily to address deferred maintenance projects in the PE Building. This fee also provides partial funding for operation and maintenance costs for the College of Education building.

Existing lab fees have not been changed for ten years. In this same time period, lab consumables and shipping costs have increased significantly, with recent COVID-related price increases exacerbating these rising costs. Equipment for student use in the department requires consumable supplies. Instruments such as a new Nuclear Magnetic Resonance Spectrometer (NMR), Gas chromatograph-Mass Spectrometer, Scanning electron microscope and High performance liquid chromatograph require costly consumable materials. Current regulations necessitating additional fees being added for transport/shipping of hazardous chemicals have contributed to lab costs. Upper division and 200 level labs are generally more expensive to operate, and they cannot continue to be operated with the current level of funding. Many of the cutting-edge instruments used during the instruction of lab courses have continuing costs related to routine maintenance and/or certification. In some cases, these are annual expenses. For example, microscopes, balances, and autoclaves must be serviced every year. In the case of the autoclaves, routine maintenance is an absolute requirement in order to guarantee safe operation. Glass breakage creates significant replacement costs each year. The department is no longer charging a separate glass breakage fee for all chemistry labs. The upgraded facilities in Yellowstone Science and Health Building will provide new capabilities for student laboratory experiences. This will include opportunities for students to have access to a functional cadaver lab and a state-of-the-art greenhouse. However, with additional capabilities come additional operating costs.

Most institutions charge full tuition/fees for non-students who want to audit a course. Prior to adoption of current technologies, this process required the Registrar's Office to collect a form on which the instructor agreed to permit the non-student to attend the course. Currently, the process requires collecting the form, researching criminal background, creating a (non)-student ID number and NetID, working with IT to create a profile, working with eLearning to provide special access to D2L, and conveying all the particulars to the non-student to provide course access. While not widely-used, MSU Billings would like to continue to maintain reduced cost access to non-student learners, but the current \$5/credit fee is too nominal for the amount of resources that are expended to assist with providing this access. This fee request will help offset some of the costs associated with providing this opportunity.

Whereas, The Office of Administration and Finance presented a list of academic, non-academic, and mandatory fee increases at the Senate meeting on March 23, 2021; and

Whereas, The fee increases represent adjustments for inflation, the rising cost of healthcare, and the expansion of Recreation Center services; and

Whereas, The Room increase of 10% per year and Board increase of 4% in year one and 3% in year two for fiscal years 2021-2023 is to cover wages, benefits, supplies, cost of food, utilities, repairs, and maintenance; and,

Whereas, The Associated Students of Montana State University Billings are growingly dissatisfied with the quality of food and the Services provided by Sodexo; and,

Whereas, The academic fee increases reflect the funds necessary for the continual function of their associated courses; and,

Whereas, The non-academic fees are presented to the Vice Chancellors after having solicited student feedback where possible and preliminary requests for both mandatory and non-mandatory fees were reviewed by the Provost, Vice Chancellor for Administration and Finance, and Vice Chancellor for Student Access and Success prior to submission to the Chancellor; and,

Whereas, The academic fees were prepared in each department and have been approved by the Deans, the Provost, and the Vice Chancellors prior to submission to the Chancellor; and.

Whereas, ASMSUB values the essential services that fees provide for student academic and cocurricular success; now, therefore, be it
