Request for authorization to enter into a lease for Gallatin College MSU; Montana State University

THAT

In accordance with the Board's authority to manage and control the Montana University System and BOR Policy 1003.6, § III, the Board of Regents authorizes Montana State University to enter into a lease agreement to support Gallatin College MSU welding fabrication, HVAC and carpentry trade programs.

EXPLANATION

- 1. Gallatin College MSU currently leases 13,851 square feet at 705 Osterman Drive in Bozeman; in addition to utilizing space at Bozeman High School for welding and several other locations for HVAC.
- 2. Gallatin College MSU enrollment is currently limited due to space constraints and difficulty of student travel between multiple sites where programs are offered.
- 3. Entering into an additional lease may provide for some consolidation of instruction, reduce the need to share space at 4 private sector locations, reduce student travel between sites and allow for the following enrollment benefits (assuming a suitably large facility can be identified to lease):
 - Increasing the number of welding graduates and eliminate or greatly reduce the existing wait list
 - Increase 1st and 2nd year HVAC students from 15 to 30 or more
 - Double the Carpentry enrollment from 12 to 24
 - Add additional programing in Welding Fabrication and Construction Trades offerings
- 4. A search for a suitable facility is underway for approximately 11,000 square feet with a lease rate up to \$15.00 per square foot for a term of up to 60 months. We expect this lease will include annual rent escalations.
- 5. Tenant improvements and triple net costs will be the responsibility of Gallatin College MSU. Due diligence is underway to assess those costs.
- 6. Before a lease is signed, MSU will work with Commissioner of Higher Education on final terms.
- 7. Funding for this lease will come from a Gallatin County ARPA grant and the Gallatin County Mill Levy previously approved for Gallatin College MSU.
