Upon the occasion of the retirement of John Xanthopoulos from the faculty of The University of Montana Western, the faculty wishes to express its appreciation for his 22 years of dedicated and valued service to the University and the State of Montana by recommending that the rank of Professor Emeritus be conferred upon him by the Board of Regents of the Montana University System.

EXPLANATION

The Division of Education requests the status of Professor Emeritus be awarded to Professor John Xanthopoulos for his 22 years of dedicated service to The University of Montana Western. Prior to coming to UMW "Dr. X" served in a variety of roles in both the K-12 and post-secondary systems in Florida as a teacher, administrator, and multicultural curriculum developer. He brought the vast knowledge gained through these endeavors to his position at UMW when he was hired in 2000.

During his time at UMW, Dr. X was an engaged scholar, regularly publishing and presenting. He has authored or co-authored more than thirty works, primarily focused on multicultural education. He also served as a reviewer for multiple peer-reviewed publications. Further, he presented locally, nationally, and internationally at countless conferences where he was able to connect his research to the field.
