# **Career Technical Education**

• Over the winter break, four classrooms on the Airport Campus were converted to SMART classrooms allowing for remote delivery of Career Technical Education course content.

- Helena College hosted Miller Electric for the "Advanced Aluminum Welding Seminar" on February 8, 2023. The training was provided to 13 professionals. Miller Electric is a strategic partner with Helena College and the Airport Campus is a regional training facility for Miller.
- Once again, Helena College will host the **Skills USA** state competition this spring. Competitions will be held on March 29 & 30 at the Airport Campus.
- Helena College's partnership with Boeing was highlighted at the Section E subcommittee legislative hearing in January.
- Helena College's CNC Machining program was selected as a testing site for Haas Technical Education Community (HTEC) certification testing. Paul Nicholson, CNC Machining instructor, will proctor the practical exams required for certification. Helena College is the only approved certification testing location in Montana.

### **Workforce Development:**

We acquired Rapid Retraining funding through Accelerate Montana to add a new look to the trucks that we
lease through Accelerate Montana funding in partnership with a local leasing agent. The Helena College
Community Education Center is now working with the Montana State Prison and the Department of
Corrections facility to paint and decal four semi-trucks and three van trailers for the Helena College CDL
program and the publicly available third-party CDL testing!

# **eLearning & Faculty Development**

Monthly meetings with the New Faculty Members will continue this spring. Topics will be around "Designing courses with equity and diversity in mind" and "Faculty expectations and academic rigor".



#### K-12 & Dual Enrollment

- Dual credit registration went very smoothly this spring. Helena High students returned to register at Helena College for their dual credit classes, solidifying this new process.
- Thanks to Montana's Future at Work grant, we were able to register 13 high school students for ECP 130 Emergency Care Provider. This course will prepare students to take the NREMT exam this spring and to pursue a career as an EMT. This story was highlighted in a report by KTVH.
- On February 22, 2023, Helena College hosted Manufacturing & Mechanics Night. High school students and their parents explored careers in the skilled trades fields by participating in activities and listening to presentations from Helena College Faculty and local industry leaders.
- On January 21, 2023, Helena College hosted the inaugural **Helena Regional First Lego Robotics Competition.**Roughly 200 students between 4<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade participated in the tournament by using Lego robots they built and programmed to complete a series of challenges. **Two all-female teams, the East Helena TechnoTiger Queens and the Belgrade Advendturefuls tied for first place.**

#### Nursing

- We are grateful to our employer partners:
  - o **Epiphany Derm** donated two exam tables and the nursing department purchased five wall units that hold assessment tools through the Perkins grant to make our space look like an authentic clinic.
  - o **Benefis Healthcare** donated a tabletop ventilator to the SIM lab to allow hands-on learning about mechanical ventilation in our labs and adds realism to the scenarios.
- We have **15 LPN students** this semester which is the largest class in years. The growth in the program is due to our partnership with Bitterroot College. (**11** in Helena and **4** in Bitterroot)

- TRIO and ASHC teamed up to offer a Welcome Back Movie Night at the Myrna Loy for the Helena College Community.
- TRIO Students and their families made 70 valentines for the seniors at the **Elkhorn Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center in Clancy.**

  asked for donations for the HC Campus Food Pantry at the Helena Safeway. It is estimated that 38 to 48% of
  two-year college students have experienced food insecurity.
