2. Increased cost of business: \$1,210,111

- Loss of HEERF funding (funding expires 6/30/2023)
 - \$590,596 = Six psychologist salary + benefits
- Increased personnel costs: \$619,515
 - > \$276,515 = 8% increase in clinical salary costs due to inflation
 - > \$243,00 = additional staff to support Student Wellness Center
 - Student Health Director, + two shared Associate Director positions (Marketing, Facilities)
- Inflation of consumable goods within medical industry

STUDENT HEALTH & WELL-BEING

- Student <u>health and wellbeing is linked to academic success</u>, retention, and persistence to graduation.
- The top four impediments to academic performance as reported by MSU students include stress, anxiety, depression, and sleep difficulties. (MSU NCHA survey 2021)
- Students who are not physically, mentally, emotionally, and socially well are more likely to leave an institution and have poorer academic performance (ACE, APA, NASPA, 2014).
- Students who withdraw and do not return to higher education primarily cite mental and behavioral health related reasons. (NAMI, 2012)
- Utilization of student health services continues to increase <u>nationally</u>. (<u>Annual Report 2019</u>; <u>HMS</u>, <u>2019</u>)
