INFORMATION ITEM <u>Proposed Revisions to Policy 301-12 "Undergraduate Degree Requirements – Associate Degrees and</u> <u>Certificate of Applied Science</u>

THAT

OCHE proposes revisions to policy 301-12.

EXPLANATION

Policy 301-12 defines the certificate and associate degree types that may be offered by MUS two-year and community college campuses for either transfer or employment. The proposed revisions would:

- 1. Define the certificate of general studies, a broadly offered credential, which recognizes completion of a general education program for transfer and is currently ill-defined in board policy.
- 2. Clarify procedures and criteria for requesting approval for associate of science or associate of arts programs longer than 60 credits.
- 3. Create clear criteria for when transfer associate degrees can carry a name designation (e.g. when they lead to employment in addition to transfer or are defined by a statewide transfer pathway in a particular transfer discipline)
