

# **Tuition Proposal**

## **Resident Rates & Non-resident Rates**

Resident/Non-resident undergraduate and graduate tuition increases range between \$4 and \$18 per credit hour, in FY26 & FY27.

- Flagships = \$18 increase per credit, \$432 annual tuition increase for full-time enrolled students
- Special Focus (STEM) = \$15 increase per credit, \$360 annual tuition increase for full-time enrolled students
- 4-year Regional = \$12 increase per credit, \$288 annual tuition increase for full-time enrolled students
- 2-year Colleges = \$4 increase per credit, \$96 annual tuition increase for full-time enrolled students

















Tuition & Fees as a Percent of Household Income












