The additional instruments have increased our overall maintenance costs along with cost increases that are industry wide. As the School of Music continues to create a civil, supportive, and respectful environment where difference and diversity are sources of strength (MSU's Strategic Plan, Values: Inclusion), our goal to perform music by underrepresented populations, many who are also living composers, continues to lead to higher costs for purchasing and renting music. Scores by living composers generally cost more than historical works. Along with the increased costs of purchasing/renting music for our current offerings, there will be an increased need to fund the purchase/rental of music for the NEW MUSI 108IA - MSU String Orchestra. The course is designed for non-music majors wanting to continue their orchestral ensemble studies who desire a more traditional 3 contact hour course.We have also seen an increase in costs for piano tuning and maintenance based on changes in service contracts. We have proposed a significant increase in building/venue rental needs. As part of our recent accreditation review (NASM), the Visitors' Report stated concern regarding adequate performance spaces that meet the acoustical and stage requirements. |
