To cover the costs of field trips associated with FCFC coursework.	In previous fiscal years, FCFC implemented a tiered fee structure for many courses, distinguishing between majors and non-majors. However, this approach presented several administrative challenges, and UM frequently encountered difficulties in accurately managing these fees. Since the vast majority of students enrolled in our fee-based courses are FCFC majors, the non-major fee has become largely unnecessary. Beginning in the 26/27 academic year, we will streamline our course fee structure by eliminating non-major fees entirely. NRSM374 is a weekend-long course to Yellowstone that previously had a major fee of \$163 and a non-major fee of \$263. To simplify and account for increased expenses associated with Enterprise rental costs, we averaged these two fees and made a slight increase. This adjustment ensures that the course remains accessible while covering the rising costs. NRSM273 is the Wilderness and Civ field course that involves extensive travel and fieldwork across Montana. Previously, the course had a major fee of \$563 and a non-major fee of \$772. To simplify and account for the significant rise in travel costs, particularly due to increased Enterprise rental expenses, we are adjusting the course fee to \$850. Lastly, other courses with a proposed \$25 fee include FCFC field trips with high travel costs, averaging over \$5,000 in expenses per semester/course. The modest \$25 fee is not intended to cover the total costs but rather to acknowledge the additional resources required for these courses.

Since this course is additive and meant to enhance learning opportunities, a course fee that covers all costs associated with the experience is warranted. The fee is being increased by a 5% inflationary factor in the second year. NRSM211 is a current fee in AY21/22 and AY22/23. The course was previously numbered NRSM210 but was changed in AY22/23. The non-major fee for this course is the same \$76 for 2024 and \$79 for 2025.	In previous fiscal years, FCFC implemented tiered fees for many courses, differentiating between majors and non-majors. Clinical rotation placement fees rival the cost of medical school rotations and are required with associated student liability insurance for each placed student. This is a growing trend across the nation as other nationally ranked programs compete for the same clinical internship spots. Our students, whether in-state or out-of-state, expect to compete for these spots to gain valuable clinical rotation experiences to take back to their chosen place of employment upon graduation.
