Housing R&R Projects since 2021: \$16M



Current Housing Inventory & Occupancy

Inventory:

- 4,767 beds across 12 residence halls
- 490 University Student Apartment units (950 bedrooms)

Occupancy (fall 2025):

- 4,641students in residence halls
- 525 student occupants in apartment units
- 5,166 total students in on campus housing
- Housing 30% of our total enrollment







Assessment study (2024)

- Factors students use when making housing decisions
- 3,603 multi-family housing units "coming soon" within 3 miles of MSU
- Maturity of our current housing facilities
- Type of room/programming preferred by students



Additional Capacity Needed to Allow Renovations

- Over past 5 years, we've been at 91-96% of capacity
- Residence halls opened this fall at over 97%
- Record number of upperclassmen choosing to live on campus
- New residence hall will provide "swing-space" for renovation projects







Next Steps

- Review & refinement of plan
 - New housing (to create swing-space capacity)
 - Deferred maintenance projects
- Request design authority at January 2026 Board of Regents meeting
