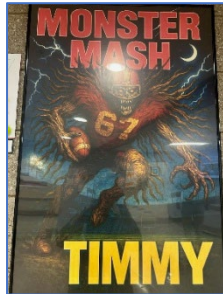
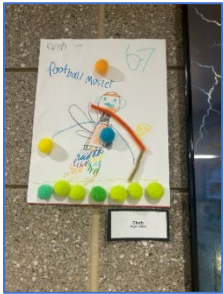


## Helena College Campus Report for January 2026 BOR Meeting

- September's activity focused on Art. The 5<sup>th</sup> graders designed their own imaginative "monsters," which were then reinterpreted and recreated by HC artist.



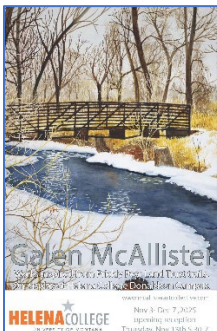
