Request for Authorization to Confer the Title of Professor Emeritus of Mathematics on Dr. Emily Stone; University of Montana-Missoula

THAT

Dr. Emily Stone retired from the faculty of The University of Montana in May of 2026. The Math Department wishes to express its appreciation for her 22 years of dedicated and valued service to the University and to the State of Montana by recommending that the rank of Professor Emeritus be conferred upon her by the Board of Regents of the Montana University System.

EXPLANATION

Dr. Stone earned her Ph.D. in Theoretical and Applied Mechanics from Cornell, and she joined the ranks of tenure-track faculty in the Math Department at UM in 2004. Emily taught across the curriculum, from 100-level courses such as Calculus to graduate-level courses in Applied Mathematics. She was also active in research and was advisor for four PhD students. Finally, Dr. Stone did a large volume of service for the Math Department, including several years as Associate Chair of the Graduate Program and six years as Department Chair. Professor Stone will be dearly missed by the Math Department.

The Math Department is pleased to nominate Dr. Emily Stone for the title of Professor Emeritus of Mathematics at The University of Montana.
