MSU held the formal [investiture](#) for its 13th president, Brock Tessman, on April 2.

MSU's spring enrollment grew for a sixth consecutive year to a [record 16,373](#) students, and Gallatin College MSU, the university's two-year college, surpassed its previous spring enrollment by 5.9%.

MSU is hosting on-campus [listening sessions](#) to inform its next strategic plan, with community sessions planned statewide this summer.

MSU was named the nation's top [military-friendly university](#), recognized for supporting veterans and military-connected students.

MSU earned the [Carnegie Community Engagement Classification](#) for outreach efforts such as the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at MSU and Shakespeare in the Schools.

MSU hosted a symposium on [artificial intelligence](#) focused on the possibilities and pitfalls of the technology for higher education and research.

Montana PBS, housed at MSU, purchased [three television stations](#) to bring free public television to eastern Montana communities for the first time.

MSU microbiologists earned a [\\$1.9 million grant](#) from the U.S. Department of Agriculture to study avian flu at the cellular level, with applications for poultry producers worldwide.

MSU's [Montana Frontier EMS Leadership Academy](#) is providing online courses for emergency medical services leaders in six rural Montana towns, helping them address funding and staffing challenges.

A Gallatin College MSU [grant](#) is providing Montana teachers and high school students with access to teaching tools and free cybersecurity certifications.

MSU's Sarah Morris won the National Science Foundation's [most prestigious award](#) for early-career researchers.

MSU hosted the [50th American Indian Council Powwow](#), one of the largest powwows in the state.
