The new roofing will be specified to carry a 20-year manufacturer's warranty.

The facility stages athletics practices and events for team sports including indoor track, rodeo, and both men=s and women's basketball; a wide range of Physical Education classes; some intramural sports programs; Recreational use for faculty staff and students; and special events such as precinct voting, concerts, Special Olympics, BACCII, local high school commencement, and MSU commencement ceremonies. The facility also houses the main Athletics Department offices, many team sports coaches offices, and the Sports Facilities Management offices.
