EDUCATION

- 1,165 high school students earned college credits through **Running Start** (dual enrollment) in FY20, providing significant savings to the state.
- More than **30% of Running Start students enroll at FVCC** after graduating from high school.
- FVCC partners with the Montana University System to help students **complete a bachelor's or graduate degree without leaving Northwest Montana.**

BUSINESS & INDUSTRY

- FVCC houses the **Northwest Small Business Development Center.**
- FVCC plays a vital role in **economic development** through education and training.
- Business and industry partners serve on **advisory boards** for all of FVCC's career and technical programs.
- FVCC works with employers to prepare students for a **growing workforce** in Northwest Montana and across the state.
