# Exceptions to the Minimum Grade Policy Montana State University - Billings 

## Applied Science

- must earn a grade of C or better in all courses in the thematic concentration


## Associate of Arts and Associate of Science Degrees

- must earn a grade of C or better in all classes used to satisfy the general education and program of study requirements


## Art

- must earn a grade of C or better for all courses used to satisfy the major and minor requirements


## Biological and Physical Sciences

- must earn a grade of C or better for all courses used to satisfy the major and minor requirements


## College of Arts and Sciences

- must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all courses in the academic major and minor


## College of Business

- must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all College of Business courses


## College of Technology Certificates and AAS Degrees

- must earn a grade of C or better in all courses used to satisfy the degree requirements


## Communication and Theatre Arts

- must earn a grade of C or better for all courses used to satisfy the major and minor requirements


## Education

- must earn a grade of C or better in all General Education courses for admission to the program
- must have a minimum GPA of 2.65 overall and in the General Education coursework for admission to the program
- must earn a grade of C or better in all courses that fulfill the degree requirements
- must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.65 in the Professional Teacher Education Core
- must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.65 in the academic major and minor, and overall


## Environmental Studies

- must earn a grade of C or better in all core requirements and restricted electives


## General Education

- must complete the general education core with a 2.0 GPA


## Health Administration

- must earn a grade of C or better and have a minimum GPA of 2.25 in the following courses for admission to upper division courses: ENGL 150, MATH 121, STAT 241, ACCT 233, ACCT 234, ECON 200, HADM 210, HADM 290


## Health and Human Performance-Health Promotion Option

- must earn a grade of C or better in all courses used to satisfy the major requirements
- must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.65 , and minimum GPA of 2.65 in General Education courses, for admission to upper division coursework


## Health and Human Performance- Human Performance Option

- must earn a grade of C or better in all courses used to satisfy the major requirements
- must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.65, and minimum GPA of 2.65 in General Education courses, for admission to upper division coursework


## History

- must earn a grade of C or better for all courses used to satisfy the major requirements


## Human Services

- must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in General Education coursework for admission to the program
- must earn a grade of B- or better in HS 201 for admission to the program
- must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all courses used to satisfy the Human Services major


## Liberal Studies

- must earn a grade of C or better in all courses in the thematic concentration


## Nursing and Health Occupations

- must earn a grade of C or better and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 in the following courses for admission to any program: HLTH 100, BIOL 113, BIOL 114, HLTH 150, ENGL 140 or 145 , CMP 105, MATH 141 or STAT 141
- must earn a grade of C or better in all courses in a given semester before enrolling in new courses
- must earn a grade of C or better in all courses used to satisfy the degree requirements


## Rehabilitation and Related Services

- must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all courses in the academic major and minor


## Teaching Option, College of Arts and Sciences

- must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.65
- please note the additional exceptions under Education
