Exceptions to the Minimum Grade Policy Montana State University – Bozeman

Agricultural Business

• must earn a grade of C or better in Econ 101S, 102SG, 201, 301, 302, and Math 170 or 181 (or their equivalents)

Business

- must earn a grade of C or better in the Business Pre-Core courses for admission to the College of Business
- must earn a grade of C or better in all business courses used to fulfill degree requirements

Civil Engineering: Civil Engineering Option, Bio-Resources Engineering Option, Construction Engineering Technology

 must earn a grade of C or better in each of the courses in the key course suite (CE 202, CHEM 131N, ENGL 121W, MATH 181M, MATH 182M, ME 115, PHYS 211N, EM 251, MATH 224M)

General Economics

- must earn a grade of C or better in these courses for admission to the program: Econ 101S, Econ 102SG, Econ 201, and Math 170 or 181 (or their equivalents)
- OR be an incoming transfer student or of freshman standing.

Media and Theatre Arts, Photography option

- must earn a grade of B or better in MTA 103
- must complete MTA 103, 264 and 265 with a minimum average GPA of 2.6
- must earn a grade of C or better in all courses used to fulfill degree requirements
- transfer students must have earned a grade of B or better in their beginning photography class

Media and Theatre Arts, Motion Picture/Video/Theatre option

• must earn a grade of C or better in all courses used to fulfill degree requirements

Music

• must earn a grade of C or better in MUS 153, or pass the guitar proficiency exam

Music Education

- must earn a grade of C or better in courses demonstrating piano and guitar proficiency, first- and second-year music theory, keyboard and aural skills, music history, conducting classes, techniques classes, and methods courses in the teaching major.
- must earn a C average in each of the pairs MUS 103 & 104, MUS 105 & 106, MUS 203 & 204, and MUS 205 & 206

Nursing

• must earn a grade of C or better in all required courses and all prerequisites to nursing courses

Political Science

• must earn a grade of C or better in all courses satisfying the degree requirements

Psychology

• must earn a grade of C or better in all prerequisites to psychology courses

Teacher Education

- must earn a grade of C or better in the teaching major, minor, professional area, and "Prerequisites for Elementary Methods Courses"
- must earn a grade of C or better in the University core communication and mathematics courses (designated core V, W, and M)
